# Agrotain opens fertilizer facilities

**Lange-Stegmann** and its subsidiary, **Agrotain International**, opened their new \$20 million urea storage warehouse and granulation production facility in North St. Louis on Tuesday.

The facilities, built for **\$20 million**, were constructed to meet the growing demand for imported urea for fertilizer.

Lange-Stegmann expects to increase employment by more than 20 percent, adding at least 20 new jobs to its existing work force.

The new St. Louis Urea Center adds 63,000 tons of fertilizer storage to Lange-Stegmann's existing space, increasing product handling capacity up to one million tons annually.

With production capacity at 125,000 tons annually, the completion of the Stabilized Nitrogen Center is expected to fulfill the growing demand for fertilizers, the companies said.

St. Louis-based Agrotain International produces fertilizer.
